Here is a list of a few assignments that follow a weekly schedule.

Spelling— Monday—1st & top half of last page of the weekly lesson
Tuesday—2 page of the lesson
Wednesday—Pretest & make sure workbook is finished
Thursday—Grade Workbooks
Friday—Final Test

Handwriting—Monday—Day 1 of current lesson
Tuesday—Day 2 of current lesson
Wednesday—Day 3 of current lesson
Thursday—Day 4 of current lesson which is to write the Bible verse on a Border Sheet & color the picture
Friday—Staple assessment paper to Daily Work & turn both Daily Work & Border Sheet in for grading.

Look for articles from some of our student editors. We will be publishing some of our writing here.




