



should be continuing. You should be DONE with your experiment. Now is the time to take your daily recorded observations and draw CONCLUSIONS.

Analyze the data Draw Conclusions What did you learn?



Does is confirm or refute your hypothesis?

Was your hypothesis correct? If not, that is OK.

Compare the hypothesis with results of experiment.

State your conclusion. Hypothesis correct?

Yes! That's great!

No, but that's okay.

Organize your data.
Use charts, graphs, line plots, etc.

- 12. Students will treasure the privilege of library time & the joy of reading.


