

This coming week is our Fall Week of Prayer. Our guest speaker will be Pastor John Hood from the Waterford SDA Church. We will be going over to the church first



## Tips for Learning Spelling Words

### Chunking Words

One of the most successful ways to learn how to spell words is chunking—breaking them apart into smaller units. Write each word on an index card so they can be reviewed.

Procedure:

#### 1. Print word on index card

- Break word apart into smaller words
- Separate them with a small space between syllables
- Color each syllable a different color  
1<sup>st</sup> green, 2<sup>nd</sup> blue, 3<sup>rd</sup> red

or

#### 2. Print word on index card

- Break word apart into smaller words
- Separate them with a small space between words
- Color each new, smaller word in a different color
