## EDUCATION GROWTH TESTING

MAP Growth tests, administered up to 3 times a year, provide a complete picture of what students in grades 3-8 know and what they are ready to learn. The tests assess in the areas of math, reading and language. They are unique in that they provide immediate feedback about a student's learning whether it is on, above or below their grade level. Metropolitan Seventh-day Adventist Junior Academy utilizes this feedback system to tailor classroom instruction and set goals for student learning.
